MEETING MINUTES October 28th, 2025

The Village Board of Trustees met in regular session on October 28th, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. at the Staplehurst Village Hall. Notice of this meeting was given in advance by posting in three designated places.

Chairperson Frank called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. and announced that the Open Meetings Act is posted on the north wall of the meeting room for public review.

Approval of Village Claims
